MEMORIZE

(Heb 4:15) " For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in **all** points tempted like as we are, **yet without sin.**" See also Luke 1:35, *esp.* "*holy thing.*"

Because He was sinless, Jesus could be the Lamb of God.

(John 1:29) "The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world."

(1 Pet 1:19) "But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:"

(Ex. 12:5) "Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year..."

As the Lamb of God, Jesus paid for the sins of the world.

MEMORIZE
