LESSON # 4 – REPENTANCE

Repent

- 1 to feel sorry or self-reproachful for what one has done or failed to do; be conscience-stricken or contrite: often with *of*
- 2 to feel such regret or dissatisfaction over some past action, intention, etc. as to change one's mind about: often with *of* {to *repent* of one's generosity}
- 3 to feel so contrite over one's sins as to change, or decide to change, one's ways; be penitent

(Rom 3:23) "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;"

(Rom 14:23 "...for whatsoever is not of faith is sin."

God calls us to Repent of Sin.

(Mark 2:17) "When Jesus heard it, he saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to **call** the righteous, but **sinner**s to **repentance**."

(Rom 2:4) "... the goodness of God *leadeth* thee to **repentance**?"

(2 Cor 7:10) "For godly sorrow worketh **repentance** to salvation ..."

Faith and Repentance are inseparable.

You can't have one without the other.



Faith says, "God's Word is Truth!" God's Word says, "All have sinned!"

Repentance is a work of Faith.

Repentance is a change of Heart.

(2 Cor 5:17) "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a **new creature**: old things are passed away; behold **all** things are become **new**."

Repentance is the evidence/works that shows/indicates a heart/mind/soul has changed
