LESSON # 5 – SANCTIFICATION

Qadash (kaw-dash') Hebrew

to be (causatively *make, pronounce, or observe* as) **clean** (ceremonially or morally):—**appoint, bid, consecrate, dedicate, defile, hallow**, (be, keep) holy (-er, place), keep, prepare, proclaim, purify, sanctify (-ied one, self), X wholly.

Translation

To dedicate/appoint something or someone to be kept/prepared wholly/totally Holy or pure.

Simply: - To be set apart

Genesis 2:3 (first mentioned)

"And God blessed the seventh day, and **sanctified** (qadash) it: because that in it he had rested (?) from all his work which God created and made."

John 17:19

"And for their sakes I **sanctify** myself, that they also might be **sanctified** through the truth."

Sanctify = set apart for a purpose

1 Thessalonians 5:23
